





The clouds burst open on December 1, 2015 over Chennai and surrounding districts turning the area into a one massive lake. The unprecedented floods led to unimaginable devastation costing lives, homes, livelihoods and infrastructure. People fled from their homes just about saving their lives. Thousands were left stranded with no place to go or no clue as to where their next meal would come from. But, in a matter of days the situation was being brought under control, thanks to an unparalleled flood of support. On December 3rd, the TNF TN Chapter Trustee Mrs. Kavitha Suresh, Treasurer TNF & Ms. Swarna Pillai Trustee TNF heard people at Vettuvakeni near East Coast Road say, "We don't have any food. We don't have any milk for the infants and babies. We are all stranded and need some help". That was it! The TNF team geared up.

So the contribution began. It was a trickle at first,

but soon it transformed into a flood that addressed immediate needs and long term rehabilitation.

The multiphase flood relief effort

- First phase Immediate relief food distribution
- Second phase Relief kits, medical camps
- Third phase Long term rehabilitation, livelihood support, repairs, renovations, constructions, education











The Tamil Nadu Foundation USA, Directors and Members raised Rs. 36.5 lakhs in 10 days.

Food was distributed at Injambakkam, Kovalam, Perungudi, Velachery and other places in Chennai and to isolated communities of Joggies at Apparkudi, Thiruvarur District and Narikurava families in Cuddalore District.

Beneficiaries - 10,121 displaced people.







Phase RELIEF KITS AND MEDICAL CAMPS

Within 26 days of the floods, Tamil Nadu Chapter received Rs. 1 crore and 75 lakh (Rs1.75 Cr) from U.S.A

This enabled the second phase of immediate rehabilitation. When the floods receded, people were faced with the daunting task of starting their life from scratch. TNF then distributed relief kits with essential household commodities such as rice, toor dhal, salt, curry powder, cooking oil, vessels and toilet kit comprising of bathing and washing soap, toothpaste, brush, coconut oil and blankets, mats and clothes.

3750 relief kits distributed.

Special relief kits were put together for school students which included school uniforms, mats, blankets, school bag, pens, pencils, erasers, notebooks, pencil box, tiffin box etc.

The kits were given to 1675 students in Chennai and 1077 students in Cuddalore.

Disease follows floods. To ward off this danger, TNF organised medical camps to treat the sick and injured. The camps were conducted across all the flood ravaged areas.



LONG TERM REHABILITATION

The funds received from Indians settled in US, through TNF chapters, Temples, Tamil Sangams and various Associations touched Rs. 3.06 Cr in 100 days.

The in-depth assessment of the damages caused and the relief required helped TNF plan various rehabilitation measures.

Krishnamurthy and his wife living across the Coovum river at Kotturpuram survived the flood. They were given an Iron Box to restart their lives. They are now happy and back in action pressing clothes to earn their bread.

Sewing Machines were distributed to 60 women affected by flood and settled in Perumbakkam tenements allotted by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. They were given three months training in tailoring by TNF.

LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT

Murugammal of Apparkudi (Jogi Community) Tiruvarur District, who lost her husband and her son to Kidney disease was given financial support to revive her livelihood through selling of toys. She was earning through begging to give treatment for her third son who is seen in the picture, also affected of Kidney disease. Her conviction to save her family transformed her from a begger to business owner with TNF's support.

REPAIRS AND RENOVATION



CRÈCHES

ICCW runs day care centres for children aged between 3 to 5 years. The children from the underprivileged societies are provided healthcare, nutrition and pre-school education. The crèches make a major contribution in their development.

TNF repaired and renovated 3 Crèches one each in KK Nagar and Adambakkam in Chennai and one in Kovur Kancheepuram District. Toys and play materials were provided to 10 crèches in Kancheepuram and Chennai.

GOVERNMENT CIRCLE LIBRARY

Ashok Nagar Public Library, Chennai, with a built-up area of 1500 sq.ft. 16,900 members and about 650 regular visitors, was totally destroyed by the floods. On the request of the Director of Public Libraries, it was repaired and renovated and is now a showpiece of the will and initiative of the American Tamil people.





THE CHALLENGES WERE MANY ..

TNF faced many tough challenges but the love for fellow human beings helped to overcome and made everything possible.

Rural Interior places, low lying house sites, bad roads made further impassable by the rains, blackouts, disrupted water supply and shortage of skilled manpower added to the woes.

Though 160 beneficieries were identified, TNF could help only 135 due to non-avalability of "Land Patta"- the title deeds.

To minimise the cost of construction, subsidised cement and steel were availed of and the low cost houses were constructed in accordance with the government's quality standards.

SUPPORTING THE "JOGI" COMMUNITY

'Jogi' community people earned their livelihood by dancing in the streets and selling inexpensive plastic items for a living. Around 80 families living in Apparkudi near Thiruthuraipoondi, Thiruvarur District, were badly affected. Their mud and thatched huts were heavily damaged by the rains and floods.

Immediate food for all members of the community and building materials were provided for rebuilding their homes

SERIOUS GAP IN EDUCATION ADDRESSED

During the relief operations, TNF identified a serious gap in the reach of education in respect of "Narikurava" & "Jogi" community students. The school dropout problem was due to following reasons

- Students displaced due to floods unable to continue their education
- Narikurava children in Ottankulam, Cuddalore and "Jogi" children in Apparkudi, Thiruvarur who accompanied their parents to work at the expense of education
- Their "fear" of flood experience




